Study programmes & European Credit System ECTS	<p>Licence (Bachelor): 3 years full time, 180 ECTS - Master: 2 years fulltime, 120 ECTS</p> <p>One academic year: 60 ECTS - One Semester: 30 ECTS</p> <p>1 credit = 20 hours (about 10h course + 10h student individual work)</p> <p>ENSA Paris-Malaquais prioritises international students who commit to validate 18 ECTS minimum each semester.</p>
Language proficiency	<p>IMPORTANT – Courses are taught in French</p> <p>Language proficiency in French: level B1 prior to arrival - No certificate is required</p>
Insurance	<p>European Union students must hold a European health card.</p> <p>International students must register to a French student health insurance (social security) at school <u>on arrival</u> in Paris. It's free and compulsory.</p> <p>You can take out a complementary health insurance contract (also known as a "mutuelle"). It's optional, but recommended.</p> <p>All students have to take a civil liability insurance (15€). It must be bought before arrival. It's compulsory to attend courses.</p>
Enrolment	<p>Documents required for registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - student registration form - photocopy of passport or identity card - 1 photo in JPEG format (300 Ko max) - photocopy of European health card (for EU student only)
Course registration	<p><u>All courses except second year Master M2</u></p> <p>Licence L1 L2 L3 (Bachelor): https://paris-malaquais.archi.fr/etudes</p> <p>Master M1: https://paris-malaquais.archi.fr/etudes</p>
